

## Scholarship Application for 2019-2020

Completing this application will allow you to apply for numerous UM-Flint scholarships using only one application! During the application process you will be asked to provide basic identifying information and submit an essay addressing several questions.

At each step your progress will be saved when you select Continue to the next step. You can continue to work on your application until it is officially submitted in Step 5.

Please note that there may be fewer questions on the actual application compared to what's highlighted on the scholarship application preview if you are applying during Phase 2 (March 25th - June 1st). In the event you are interrupted or are unable to complete the application at one sitting, you'll be able to return to the application for completion and submission by the deadline date, February 15, 2019. Remember: You file the application only once.

- Describe any projects or research undertaken—including experiences in tutoring or teaching (if applicable).
- Describe the impact of education on your personal growth and development.
